Local Leader Position Description

Local Leaders are students who drive the McDaniel Local experience for our new students and help shape an entirely new orientation experience for McDaniel. Local Leader responsibilities include, but are not limited to:

- *Represent and model all the positive qualities of a McDaniel student by guiding and welcoming new students*
- *Connect students to McDaniel & the local community through experiential learning opportunities*
- *Lead sessions on topics like community engagement, entrepreneurship, and student leadership on and off campus*
- *Supervise students in the residence halls, including providing conflict mediation and enforcing college and program policies*
- *Assist the CEO staff in set-up and clean-up, and other duties surrounding program activities*
- *Foster an environment that helps new students develop an identity as McDaniel community members*

- *Develop and refine leadership skills and participate in resume-building professional development opportunities*
- *Network with McDaniel and Westminster community professionals*

Qualifications & Expectations

- Have and maintain a minimum cumulative GPA of 2.5, and have a good disciplinary record at McDaniel College
- Participate in the required interview day on Saturday, March 30th and if selected, attend Meet & Greet event on Tuesday, April 16
